Latest Council Action

The following is a summarized list of the actions taken by the City Council during their meeting on **Thursday, August 22, 2024**:

1) **Citywide Housing Element Adoption** -Council adopted the Housing Element of the City's General Plan, after conditional approval by the CA Department of Housing and Community Development.

2) **MidPen Loan Amendment** - Council adopted a resolution authorizing the City Manager to amend a loan to fund the development of affordable to low-income residential units at 1098 38th Avenue.

3) **League Voting Delegates-** City Council nominated Vice Mayor Brooks to serve as Capitola's voting delegate at the League of CA Cities Annual Conference in September.

4) **City Banking Services** - City Council awarded a banking services agreement to Santa Cruz County Bank.

5) **City Attorney Services** - City Council renewed the contract with Burke, William, Sorensen LLP for legal counsel.
