Consent Items Included:

• Authorization of an agreement for auditing services.

General Government:

1) City Hall Needs Assessment - Council received a presentation from Group 4 Architecture on Phase I of City Hall Needs and Assessment and Alternatives Analysis and asked that staff bring Phase 2 for consideration/prioritization during the upcoming budget process.

2) Jade Street Park Universally Accessible Playground (Treasure Cove) Project -Council authorized the execution of Amendment 1 to the agreement with Verde Design for final plans, specifications, and estimates for the Jade Street Park Universally Accessible Playground Project.
