ADU Plans Available

Are you interested in building an accessory dwelling unit (ADU) in Capitola? The City has resources for you to make the process as quick and stress-free as possible!

To streamline the permitting process, the City of Capitola has FREE pre-approved ADU plans available: they are building code approved by Capitola's Building Official. The program offers five floor plans and three exterior design styles, designed for a typical lot within the city. These construction documents include design details, material guidelines, and architectural standards. Pre-Designed ADUs go through the Limited Review (Level 1) Permitting Process if the 4' side and rear setback requirements are met. However, while these ADU designs have already been pre-approved by the City, additional site specific information (like a parcel survey and soils report) is required for a building staff review to demonstrate how the ADU will fit within your property.

The following is a summarized list of the action taken by City Council during the agenda of the **Thursday**, **May 23**, **2024**, City Council meeting:

Consent Items Included:

 Accepting the BIA's annual report and proposed budget, and setting a public hearing for June 13, 2024, for Council to consider levying assessments.

General Government:

- 1) COE Bylaws & FY 2023-24 Goals Council approved the amendment to the Commission on the Environment bylaws and the commission's three-year Environment Goals.
- 2) Parks Use Policy & Resolution Council adopted the City Park and Reservation Permit Use Policy and asked for a 6-month Council review of the program.
- 3) Community Center Renovation Project Council approved agreements with the project architect and a construction management firm to manage and complete the renovation of the Jade Street Community Center.
