Latest Council Action

The following is a summarized list of the action taken by City Council during the agenda of the **Thursday**, **June 27**, **2024**, City Council meeting:


- 1)Finance Advisory Committee Appointments Council appointed two Business Representatives to the FAC for the term expiring December 31, 2024.
- 2) 2024 General Municipal Election Council approved two resolutions: one ordering the election and consolidating with the County and one submitting a ballot measure to voters to increase the City's sales-tax through 2034. For more information on the election and the measure, click here.
- 3) **VDUBlicious Car Show** Council denied a request for an event on August 10 and encouraged the organizers to work with City staff to identify a date later in the year.
- **4) Cliff Drive Resiliency Project** Staff provided Council with a progress report outlining three options to improve cliff resiliency.
- 5) Memorandum of Understanding and Employee Contracts Council approved three-year agreements with one employee group, and approved contracts with Department Heads and the City Manager.
- **6) Fiscal Year 2024-2025 Budget -** Council adopted the budget for full year 2024 2025; the new fiscal year begins on July 1, 2024.

The General Municipal Election will be held on November 5, 2024, for the offices of two (2) City Council Members. The City Clerk will issue nomination papers to prospective candidates from July 15 to August 9, 2024 (CA Elections Code § 10220).
