The following is a summarized list of the actions taken by the City Council during their meeting on Thursday, September 26, 2024:

1) Recognition of 2024 Junior Guard **Participants** The Mavor presented _ certificates of recognition to 5 youth participants of the 2024 Junior Guards.

2) Daylighting Law AB 413- Village Parking -Council reviewed staff's proposed approach to the modification of selected parking spaces in the Village to comply with AB 413, effective in California January 2025.

3) Public Art Project - Council approved a begonia commemorative public art project to be installed near the corner of Wharf Rd, and Cliff Dr. near Stockton Bridge.
