NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at its meeting on June 27, 2024, the Capitola City Council adopted Resolution No. 4385 calling the election to place a ballot measure for voters' consideration regarding the repealing of the existing one-quarter cent (0.25%) transaction and use ("Sales") tax and replacing it with a one-half cent (0.50%) sales tax to maintain fiscal stability and protect essential city facilities and services. It is anticipated to generate about \$2.2 million annually in General Fund revenues.
