1	Is the Bidding Contractor responsible for determining the Excavation Volumes before the Bid or is the Awarded Contractor to verify the Earthwork Volumes before construction?	Section 2.03 of the Specs states that the quantities provided (including the earthworks volumes) are estimates. The bidder is responsible for determining their own unit pricing based on the estimated earthworks quantities. Once awarded, the contractor should prepare their own takeoffs before grading is performed.
2	Who is responsible for Geotechnical Observation and Testing?	Spec Section 11.05 L Says contractor is responsible for engaging geotech
3	Who is responsible for hiring an Arborist and define the scope of tree work	See Plan Sheet L-2.0. The contractor will be responsible for removal of trees shown in the red bubble. The City of Capitola will be responsible for hiring an arborist to trim or prune any trees shown to be protected in place.
4	Please provide contact information for any precast people you have been in contact with	See Plan Sheet L-1.6. Existing balustrades, top rail and column sections will be made available for molding.
5	Are there any PG&E Fees and if so who is responsible for paying them? If the contractor is responsible for paying can you tell us what the fees are?	Electrical engineer did not anticipate shut off would be required for installing guy wire and staightening pole. Should the contractor believe that a shut down is required, the contractor shall inform the City of the shut down and provide anticipated fees from PG&E. City will be responsible for fees in that case.
